



Incentive Funds Available

Small to medium sized manufacturers located in Washington State may be eligible for incentive funds through the Washington State University Extension Energy Program (Energy Program)

- Ideal candidates are energy efficiency projects in need of additional funding support to help “tip the scales” into implementation
- Electric and/or natural gas savings qualify
- The serving utility keeps the conservation credits
- Awards range from approximately \$5,000 to \$10,000
- The Energy Program expects to help fund around 10 projects per year between 2007 and 2009, for a total of 30 projects statewide

These funds are intended to help small to medium sized manufacturers with projects that would otherwise not be implemented without assistance.

Washington state industries may also contact the Energy Program to access engineering technical assistance, energy assessments, industrial best practices trainings, support with Combined Heat and Power projects and advocacy, and more. This support is made possible through state and federal funding.
